Today's Daily Prayer – This poor widow put in more than all the other contributors.

At the time of Jesus, power and status were everything and Jesus particularly targets the scribes and Pharisees. The scribes were experts in the law, judges and lawyers. In many parts of the Roman Empire, Jews lived in self-governing enclaves and the scribes were civil leaders and their knowledge and ability would contribute to the survival and growth of God's people. Jesus does not attack their power or position; he attacks their self-important manner, their pomposity and arrogance. He suggests that they are taking the money in the treasury (which was meant to help the poor) to line their own pockets.

Jesus sat down opposite the treasury, and observed how the crowd put money into the treasury.

Many rich people put in large sums. A poor widow also came and put in two small coins worth a few cents.

Calling his disciples to himself, he said to them, 'Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood.' Mark 12: 38-44


